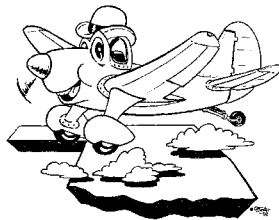

2009 Okie Derby Information

Proficiency Air Derby: The Okie Derby is a proficiency event sponsored by the Oklahoma Chapter Ninety-Nines, Inc. All pilots are invited to participate, male or female. Two-person crews are required; co-pilot or navigator need not be a licensed pilot. Pilot may elect to take passengers also.

Aircraft Entry: Any type stock airplane, single or twin.

Entry Fee: \$40 per plane if postmarked before August 7, 2009. Then, entry fee is \$50.00.

Impoundment: 1:00 – 6:00 p.m. on Friday, August 14, 2009, at Wiley Post Airport, Oklahoma City, OK. Aircraft fuel tanks will be topped Friday evening to permit early takeoff Saturday morning. Aircraft will start the Derby with full tanks.

Secret Course: The race course will remain a secret until the mandatory Friday evening pilot briefing.

Pilot Briefing: 6:30 p.m., Friday, August 14, 2009, at the Page Building, Wiley Post Airport, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. This briefing is a **MANDATORY** requirement for all pilots.

Okie Derby Takeoff: 8:00 a.m., Saturday, August 15, 2009

Trophies: Pilot and co-pilot trophies for eight places, plus miscellaneous trophies.

Scoring: The object of this Derby is to demonstrate the ability of the contestant to fly a cross-country course in such a manner as to most clearly equal the contestant's speed and fuel handicaps.

Each contestant sets his/her own handicap by indicating on the entry form the **GROUND SPEED** he/she plans to fly the course. Fuel estimates are turned in Saturday morning just prior to the start. Scores will be determined by matching each contestant's actual performance against his/her speed handicap and fuel estimate, with speed and fuel each accounting for half the score.

Hospitality: The Oklahoma Chapter 99s invites all participants including pilots, co-pilots volunteers, friends of Okie Derby, etc. to visit the hospitality room at the Page Building on Friday afternoon prior to the briefing.
