

Congratulations To Wally Funkl




Blue Origin is sponsoring a table at the Texas Aviation Hall of Fame ceremony on April 19, honoring the induction of 99s member **Wally Funk**. If you are a younger member who does not know who Wally Funk is, and what she has accomplished in her life, just Google her, or visit The 99s Museum of Women Pilots and The Ninety-Nines website. Born Mary Wallace Funk in 1939, Wally was born to fly. Attending Stephens College in Columbia Missouri at 16

College in Columbia, Missouri at 16, she joined the women's flying club and earned her pilot's license at age 17. For the next 60 years Wally realized her dreams started as a young girl, overcoming barriers and obstacles along the way. She holds numerous aviation certificates and ratings. She is an accomplished flight instructor teaching hundreds to fly and helping thousands more earn advanced ratings. In 1968 she earned her Airline Transport Pilot rating only to be turned down by airlines because she was a woman. Undeterred, she became the Federal Aviation Administration's first female flight inspector and in 1974 the National Transportation and Safety female Investigator. Board's first 1961. volunteered for the First Lady Astronaut Trainees (FLATs) program, known today as the "Mercury 13." Wally never stopped dreaming of going to space, and on July 20, 2021, aboard the Blue Origin NS-16, Wally became the oldest person to fly in space at that time at age 82.

The Professional Pilot Leadership Initiative (PPLI) is a mentoring program which will connect you with other supportive fellow Ninety -Nines.



First Wings Award Attention Student Pilots!

The spring **First Wings Award** deadline is 1 April. If you are a student pilot who has been a member of the 99s since on or before 1 January 2024, and have logged at least five hours of flight training in the six months prior to the application deadline of April 1, you may qualify for an award of up to \$6000. An updated version of the application will be available on the international website on or about 1 February.

If you are preparing to apply here are some tips:

- Download the application before filling any fields the online form does not save any information you enter. Read the instructions carefully. Where bullet points are part of the instructions, be sure to cover those points at minimum – a little bit extra will be fine too.
- If you need a mentor (any 99s member can help you!), contact Jane Link to help you find one.
- The 99s Recommendation and Certification pages (Part VII and VIII) are completed by the Chapter scholarship chairman, Jane Link, after the application is submitted.
- The Colorado Chapter is in the South Central Section.
- Necessary documents may be captured on a phone or scanner, but make sure they are complete, clean, **readable** and straight as possible.
 Email your application to the Chapter AEMFS chairman, Jane Link no later than 1 April.




47th Annual Air Race Classic: Carbondale, Illinois to Loveland, Colorado
